Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/48/L.33

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 43rd meeting, on 18 December 1993, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/48/54) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/48/L.33. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/48/SR.43).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/48/L.33, no additional appropriation would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995. The question of additional premises that might be required would need to be examined by the Secretary-General and the Executive Heads of the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Population Fund and the United Nations Children's Fund and the Secretary-General should report thereon to the General Assembly, through the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions.
