FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS TRANSITIONAL AUTHORITY
IN CAMBODIA

Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

- 1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia (UNTAC) (A/C.5/48/40, paras. 39-46).
- 2. By its resolution 47/209 B of 14 September 1993, the General Assembly authorized the Secretary-General to enter into commitments of up to \$100 million for the period from 1 September to 31 December 1993, subject to the Advisory Committee's prior concurrence.
- 3. The Secretary-General now estimates the requirements of UNTAC through its final liquidation, currently projected at 30 April 1994, at \$134,357,000 gross (\$127,690,000 net). As stated in paragraph 125 (g) of his report, he requests the appropriation and apportionment of that amount.
- 4. Bearing in mind its resumed session in February 1994, at which time it will have before it the full report on the financing of UNTAC, the Advisory Committee recommends that at this stage the existing commitment authority of \$100 million be maintained through 31 March 1994 and that it be assessed.
