FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS OBSERVER MISSION IN EL SALVADOR

Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

- 1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Observer Mission in El Salvador (ONUSAL) (A/C.5/48/40, paras. 34-38).
- 2. The current mandate of ONUSAL covers the period from 1 December 1993 to 31 May 1994; by its resolution 47/234 of 14 September 1993, the General Assembly authorized the Secretary-General to enter into commitments for ONUSAL at a rate not to exceed \$3,000,000 gross (\$2,720,000 net) per month for the four-month period from 1 December 1993 to 31 March 1994.
- 3. In paragraph 36 of his report, the Secretary-General states that additional expenditure will arise during the election period from 15 to 31 March 1994; consequently, the cost of maintaining ONUSAL for the five-month period from 1 December 1993 to 30 April 1994 is estimated at \$18,137,400 gross (\$16,475,500 net), i.e., some \$3.1 million gross more than the cost of a five-month period based on the current authorized rate of commitments of \$3 million gross per month.
- 4. In paragraph 125 (f) of the same report, the Secretary-General requests the appropriation and apportionment of the amount of \$18,137,400 gross (\$16,475,500 net) for the period from 1 December 1993 to 30 April 1994.
- 5. Bearing in mind that the Advisory Committee will examine the detailed performance report of ONUSAL in February 1994 and that the current authorization of \$12 million gross covers the period up to 31 March 1994, the Advisory Committee recommends that at this stage the amount of \$12 million gross (\$10,880,000 net) be maintained and that the amount be assessed.
