Draft decision recommended by the Commission on Human
Rights at its fifty-first session for adoption by the
Economic and Social Council

At its fifty-first session, the Commission on Human Rights recommended the following draft decision for adoption by the Economic and Social Council. In view of the urgency of the matter, as expressed in the letter from the Chairman of the Commission to the President of the Council (see E/1995/54), it is suggested that the Council consider the draft decision, which will appear in the report of the Commission on the work of its fifty-first session (E/1995/23), at its resumed organizational session.

"Situation of human rights in Burundi

"The Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1995/90 of 8 March 1995, approves the Commission's demand to the Chairman of the Commission to appoint rapidly, after consultation with the Bureau, a special rapporteur with the task of drawing up, on the basis of all the information he considers relevant and his contacts with the Burundi authorities and population, a report on the situation of human rights in Burundi for submission to the Commission at its fifty-second session."
