FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION IN HAITI

Draft decision submitted by the Chairman

The General Assembly,

In accordance with the framework set out in General Assembly resolution $48/_$ of $_$ December 1993,*

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of seventeen peace-keeping operations $\underline{1}$ / and the related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions $\underline{2}$ / and concurring with the observations of the Advisory Committee,

- (a) <u>Decides</u>, on an exceptional basis, to authorize the Secretary-General to enter into commitments up to the amount of 1,383,000 United States dollars gross (1,364,000 dollars net) for the United Nations Mission in Haiti for the period from 23 September 1993 to 22 March 1994, and requests the Secretary-General to establish a special account for the United Nations Mission in Haiti;
- (b) <u>Decides also</u>, as an ad hoc arrangement, to apportion the amount indicated in paragraph (a) above among Member States in accordance with the composition of groups set out in paragraphs 3 and 4 of General Assembly resolution 43/232 of 1 March 1989, as adjusted by the Assembly in its

resolutions 44/192 B of 21 December 1989, 45/269 of 27 August 1991, 46/198 A of 20 December 1991, 47/218 A of 23 December 1992 and 48/___ of __ December 1993,* and taking into account the scale of assessments for the years 1992, 1993 and 1994 as set out in General Assembly resolution 46/221 A of 20 December 1991 and General Assembly decisions 47/456 of 23 December 1992 and 48/___ of __ December 1993;**

(c) <u>Decides further</u> that, in accordance with the provisions of its resolution 973 (X) of 15 December 1955, there shall be set off against the apportionment among Member States, as provided for in paragraph (b) above, their respective share in the Tax Equalization Fund of the estimated staff assessment income of 19,000 dollars for the period from 23 September 1993 to 22 March 1994.
