LETTER DATED 10 MAY 1995 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF  
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions of my Government, I am writing to you to inform you that today, 10 May 1995, at 1305 local time, the Muslim forces from Bosnia and Herzegovina shelled the town of Mali Zvornik in the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. As a result of the shelling, one person was killed and two were wounded.

The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia will not tolerate aggression against its territory. In the future, exercising its legitimate right to self-defence, in such or similar cases, it will be compelled to respond adequately in order to protect its territory and population against aggression.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
