LETTER DATED 11 MAY 1995 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to your letter dated 5 May 1995 (S/1995/386), containing suggestions for the implementation of Security Council resolutions 981 (1995), 982 (1995), 983 (1995) and 990 (1995), of 31 March and 28 April 1995, by which the Council established the United Nations Confidence Restoration Operation in Croatia (UNCRO), the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) and the United Nations Preventive Deployment Force (UNPREDEP), and approved the recommendation, in paragraph 84 of your report (S/1995/222), for the establishment of United Nations Peace Forces headquarters (UNPF-HQ).

The members of the Council have taken note of your suggestions regarding the composition of the military contingents of UNCRO, UNPROFOR and UNPREDEP, and the proposed composition of UNPF-HQ, as well as your desire to maintain the United Nations military observers as currently composed, to be deployed, as needed, in the three zones of operation of UNCRO, UNPROFOR and UNPREDEP. They agree with the proposal contained in your letter.
