Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 43rd meeting, on 18 December 1993, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/48/59) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions A/48/L.29, A/48/L.30 and A/48/L.31/Rev.1. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/48/SR.43).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, based on the statement by the Secretary-General of programme budget implications (A/C.5/48/59) and the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, should it adopt draft resolutions A/48/L.29, A/48/L.30 and A/48/L.31/Rev.1, no additional appropriation would be required under sections 3A, Policy-making organs, and 3C, Department of Political Affairs II, 24, Public information, and 25E, Conference services, of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995, but the provision under section 3A for the special allocations of the Special Committee against Apartheid would be reduced by \$690,000.
