NOTE VERBALE DATED 12 JANUARY 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CYPRUS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Cyprus to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to Security Council resolution 883 (1993) adopted on 11 November 1993, has the honour to report on the following measures instituted by Cyprus for meeting the obligations set out in paragraphs 3 to 7 of the said resolution:

- (a) The Council of Ministers, on 22 December 1993, with resolution No. 40.350, decided on immediate action by all competent authorities on all of the necessary measures for full compliance with the provisions of resolution 883 (1993);
- (b) Subsequently, the Central Bank of Cyprus issued a circular-letter, by which it calls upon all domestic and offshore banks that conduct business in Cyprus to comply fully with the stipulations of the new resolution;
- (c) The Minister of Trade and Industry will issue an order in which the export, re-export and transit of goods to the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya as mentioned in the annex and in paragraph 5 of the resolution will be forbidden;
- (d) In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 6, the Libyan side was called upon to shut down the offices of Libyan Airlines in Cyprus. The Libyan side complied with the directions, shut down the offices in Nicosia and is now repatriating the two employees to the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

The Permanent Representative of Cyprus to the United Nations would like to underline the determination of the Government of Cyprus to comply fully with all the provisions of the said resolution.
