NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 JANUARY 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF
CUBA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Cuba to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and has the honour to inform him, in accordance with paragraph 13 of Security Council resolution 883 (1993) and on instructions from the pertinent Cuban authorities, that the Government of Cuba has taken due note of the obligations set out in paragraphs 3 to 7 of that resolution. The contents of the resolution have been circulated to all the national bodies concerned, despite the fact that, in Cuba, there are no funds of Libyan undertakings or institutions, no commercial transactions are carried out with the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya in connection with the supply of equipment and technology for the petroleum industry, nor is any type of relation maintained with Libyan Arab Airlines.

It also informs the Secretary-General that the level of the Libyan diplomatic staff at Havana is the same as that prevailing when the Security Council adopted resolution 748 (1992).
