SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/1994/20 of 14 January 1994.

During the week ending 15 January 1994, the Security Council took action on the following items:

<u>The question concerning Haiti</u> (see S/25070/Add.24 and Corr.1, S/25070/Add.34, S/25070/Add.35, S/25070/Add.37, S/25070/Add.38, S/25070/Add.41, S/25070/Add.43 and S/25070/Add.46; see also S/22110/Add.39)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3328th meeting, held on 10 January 1994, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President of the Security Council stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the full text, see S/PRST/1994/2; to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council, Forty</u>-ninth Year, Resolutions and decisions of the Security Council, 1994).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3329th meeting, held on 14 January 1994, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the question of South Africa (S/1994/16).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of South Africa, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In response to the request contained in a letter dated 14 January 1994 from the representatives of Djibouti, Nigeria and Rwanda on the Security Council (S/1994/33), the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Kingsley Makhubela.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1994/28), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1994/28 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 894 (1994) (for the full text, see S/RES/894 (1994); to be issued in <u>Official Records of the Security Council</u>, Forty-ninth Year, Resolutions and decisions of the Security Council, 1994).
