NOTE VERBALE DATED 29 MARCH 1994 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The Secretary-General of the United Nations presents his compliments to the President of the Security Council and, in accordance with paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 816 (1993), has the honour to bring to his attention further information received by UNPROFOR regarding apparent violations of the ban on flights in the airspace of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Between 21 and 28 March 1994, there appear to have been 20 flights of fixed- or rotary-wing aircraft in the airspace of Bosnia and Herzegovina other than those exempted in accordance with paragraph 1 of resolution 816 (1993) or approved by UNPROFOR in accordance with paragraph 2 of that resolution. Details as to the itinerary of flights in this reporting period are attached as the annex to this note verbale.

The total number of flights assessed as apparent violations is now 1,556.

1560	21 Mar	10.54	11.14	United Nations Military Observers personnel observed a white and dark blue Gazelle, with "Milicia" written in Cyrillic on the fuselage, take off at Zaluzani. The unauthorized flight occurred in an area controlled by Bosnian Serbs.	South Low Slow

AWACS made radar contact, and NATO fighter aircraft made momentary visual contact with this helicopter, flying at very low altitude, heading southwest, then reversing back towards the airfield. United Nations Military Observers personnel observed this helicopter land again at Zaluzani. The unauthorized flight occurred in an area controlled by Bosnian Serbs. 1576	27 Mar	12.30	13.35	This flight began as an UNPROFOR approved MEDEVAC of a green MI-8 helicopter with a red cross, from Banja Luka to Knin. It became a violation when it deviated from its approved flight path by not returning to Banja Luka. The helicopter took off from Knin without picking up any patients and flew to an unknown location (probably Udbina). The unauthorized flight occurred in an area controlled by Bosnian Serbs. 1577 1578	28 Mar	08.15	11.40	These flights began as UNPROFOR approved MEDEVACS of two white MI-8 helicopters with blue stripes and red crosses from Divulje to Kiseljak. They became violations when United Nations Military Observers in Kiseljak were denied access to the helicopters to inspect the flights and cargo. 41 passengers were manifested but a total of 63 emerged in Kiseljak, including one soldier in uniform. 15 boxes were off-loaded from the helicopters. United Nations Military Observers were not allowed to inspect these boxes and they were not noted by European Community Monitoring Mission (ECMM) inspectors in Split. The unauthorized flight of these helicopters occurred in an area controlled by Bosnian Croats.	Landing Low Slow
