"I have the honour to refer to document A/35/786-S/14311 of 30 December 1980 which contains the information that I have been nominated as a candidate by the national group of Argentina in the election to take place to fill the vacancy in the International Court of Justice caused by the death of Judge Richard R. Baxter. While I am deeply sensible of the honour done to me, I very much regret that at this time I am not in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court.
