With reference to the letter dated 31 January 1994 addressed to you by the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of Eritrea, which was distributed as a document of the Security Council (S/1994/103), the Government of the Sudan wishes to inform you of the following:

1. The Government of the Sudan draws attention to the contents of its letter dated 24 January 1994 addressed to the President of the Security Council, which was distributed as a document of the Council (S/1994/71).

2. In consideration of the fraternal relations between the two countries, the Government of the Sudan, following the issuance of document S/1994/34 and the reply to it in document S/1994/71, hastened to dispatch a high-ranking delegation to Eritrea with a view to reaching agreement with the Eritrean authorities on how to deal with all the issues within a bilateral framework and on putting an end to the repeated letters and replies to them.

3. On that basis, the Sudan does not wish to comment on the second letter referred to above and addressed to you by the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Eritrea to the United Nations.
