LETTER DATED 3 FEBRUARY 1994 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF ARMENIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Letter dated 3 February 1994 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Armenia addressed to the President of the Security Council

Despite all the efforts of the international community to establish a durable cease-fire and start peaceful negotiations, in mid-December 1993, Azerbaijan launched a new offensive on Nagorny Karabakh, which continues till today unabated. As a result, thousands of people have died, among them a large number of civilians. As part of this new aggression, Azerbaijanis indiscriminately bombarded civilian centres of Nagorny Karabakh and the border regions of Armenia (see attached annex for the chronology and the sites of the shellings in Armenia).

To mount this new offensive, Azerbaijan has assembled a coalition army of mujahidin fighters, Ukrainian and Russian mercenaries and Turkish and Russian military advisers. There have also been unconfirmed news reports of involvement of still other non-Azerbaijani arms, mercenaries and advisers.

Should these prove correct, they are in clear violation of all Security Council resolutions on the Nagorny Karabakh conflict and specifically of paragraph 10 of resolution 853 (1993) urging "States to refrain from the supply of any weapons and munitions which might lead to an intensification of the conflict".

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Armenia is deeply concerned about the participation of foreign nationals in the Nagorny Karabakh conflict and the emerging evidence of the presence of non-Soviet-made weapons in the hands of Azeri soldiers, which contribute to the further escalation of the Nagorny Karabakh conflict, and more dangerously, to a new level of internationalization of the conflict.

We call upon the members of the Security Council to review this matter and take appropriate measures to ensure that United Nations Member States comply with the Security Council resolutions.
