Letter dated 13 June 1995 from the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency addressed to the Secretary-General

Security Council resolution 699 (1991), approved on 17 June 1991, requests, inter alia, the Secretary-General to submit to the Security Council progress reports on the implementation of the plan for the destruction, removal or rendering harmless of the items specified in paragraph 12 of resolution 687 (1991). Such reports are to be submitted every six months after the adoption of resolution 699 (1991). The next report is therefore due on 17 June 1995.

During the period under review, from 17 December 1994 to 17 June 1995, no development is to be reported relevant to the destruction, removal or rendering harmless of the items specified in paragraph 12 of resolution 687 (1991), nor in any other area of IAEA's activities in Iraq beyond what was reported to the Council in document S/1995/287 of 11 April 1995.

The implementation of the IAEA's ongoing monitoring and verification plan continues. A detailed report on these activities will be submitted, as requested in resolution 715 (1991), by 17 October 1995.

Kindly bring the content of this letter to the attention of the Council.
