Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a communication dated 13 March 1995, addressed to States parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, the Secretary-General drew attention to the vacancy in the International Court of Justice caused by the death of Judge Roberto Ago (Italy) on 24 February 1995. In the same communication, the Secretary-General, in accordance with article 5, paragraph 1, of the Statute of the Court, invited the national groups of States parties to the Statute to undertake the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court. The Secretary-General further requested that nominations should be received no later than 31 May 1995. The nominations thus received have appeared in document A/49/910-S/1995/449.

2. The Secretary-General received the following nominations by national groups after 31 May 1995:
