FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS PEACE-KEEPING FORCES IN THE MIDDLE EAST: UNITED NATIONS INTERIM FORCE IN LEBANON

Draft decision submitted by the Chairman following informal consultations

The General Assembly,

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Secretary-General on the financing of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon $\underline{1}$ / and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, $\underline{2}$ /

Bearing in mind Security Council resolution 425 (1978) of 19 March 1978, by which the Council established the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon, and the subsequent resolutions by which the Council extended the mandate of the Force, the latest of which was resolution 974 (1995) of 30 January 1995,

Recalling its resolution S-8/2 of 21 April 1978 on the financing of the Force and its subsequent resolutions thereon, the latest of which was resolution 49/226 of 23 December 1994,

Decides that there shall be set off against the apportionment among Member States, in respect of such future mandate period(s) as may be approved by the Security Council, their respective share in the unencumbered balance of 1,755,000 United States dollars gross (16,000 dollars net) for the period from 1 February 1994 to 31 January 1995, inclusive.
