• Intensify cooperation with regard to the reduction of natural disasters and major technological and anthropogeneous catastrophes in order to enhance the capabilities of affected developing countries and countries with economies in transition to cope with such situations.

(b) <u>Replace</u> the second sentence by the following:

There is a clear mandate in the Charter for the United Nations to promote higher standards of living, full employment and conditions of economic and social progress, as well as the solutions to international economic, social and related problems. To achieve these purposes, all members of the United Nations have pledged themselves to take joint and separate action in cooperation with the Organization. In many respects, however, these have not been fulfilled.

3. Paragraph 12

Replace the paragraph by the following:

The need for action in these fields has never been more urgent. One fifth of the world's people live in abject poverty, and the gap between the developed and developing countries remains unacceptably high. Moreover, accelerating globalization and interdependence in the world economy call for policy measures that will maximize the new opportunities for all countries to benefit from them and keep uncertainties and potential negative effects to the lowest level possible. Only through unprecedented measures of international cooperation for sustained economic growth and sustainable development can we ever meet these enormous challenges.

4. <u>Paragraph 13</u>

(b) <u>Replace</u> the last two sentences by the following:

As a result, a consensus has emerged on the need for an integrated approach for international cooperation for development oriented towards promoting sustained economic growth and sustainable development.

 - (a) <u>Insert</u> the following new subparagraph before the first subparagraph:
 - Implementing all the commitments as embodied in such milestone agreements relevant for international cooperation for development in the 1990s and beyond as the Declaration adopted at the eighteenth special session of the General Assembly, the International Development Strategy for the Fourth United Nations Development Decade, Agenda 21 and the outcome of the World Summit for Social Development.

- (e) Add the following new subparagraph as the last subparagraph:
- Increasing the representation and participation of developing countries in international economic decision-making processes and mechanisms in the spirit of democracy and with a view to making more effective the management of the globalized world economy for common prosperity.

- Encourage universal ratification of existing multilateral treaties and compliance with the obligations arising from them
- Promote the further codification and progressive development of international law, aimed in particular at pursuing economic and social progress and better standards of living in larger freedom and universal respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms
- Promote the building and maintenance of fair and just societies, in which all people are able to participate
- Encourage resort to means and methods for the peaceful settlement of disputes between States.
