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LETTER DATED 11 JULY 1995 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 17 March 1995, at 1100 hours, nine Iraqi forces were observed installing barbed wire near the geographical coordinates of NC 548-416 on the map of Sumar, in no man's land, north of Mian-Tangeh Darreh post and west of border pillar 43.
2. On 17 March 1995, at 1145 to 1725 hours, four Iraqi fighting helicopters were observed flying from near the geographical coordinates of ND 385-086 on the map of Khosravi, west of border pillar 54 and south of Iraqi's Amraveh towards the city of Khaneghein.
3. On 17 March 1995, at 1640 hours, nine Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker near the geographical coordinates of NC 417-985 on the map of Khosravi, south-west of border pillars 51 and 52, east of Molah-Aziz, and height point 250.
4. On 19 March 1995, four Iraqi Toyota vehicles carrying passengers were observed patrolling for 45 minutes near the geographical coordinates of PB 205-470 on the map of Kouhe-Tunnel, in no man's land, between south-west of border pillar 27/5 and south-east of border pillar 27/6.
5. On 21 March 1995, from 1115 to 1745 hours, seven Iraqi helicopters were observed flying near the geographical coordinates of ND 335-015 on the map of Khosravi. Two helicopters landed near the geographical coordinates of ND 356-030 on the map of Khosravi and left the area at 1510 hours.
6. On 21 March 1995, Iraqi forces fired five tracer bullets by Dooshka machine-guns towards the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran. The bullets hit the ground near south of border pillar located at the geographical coordinates of TP 228-721 on the map of Khorramshahr.
7. On 22 March 1995, at 1850 hours, four military armed personnel clad in khaki, aboard a khaki-coloured patrol vehicle began taking film from the

positions of the Islamic Republic of Iran for 20 minutes and from an estimated distance of 500 metres at the geographical coordinates of PB 470-702 on the map of South Mehran, in no man's land, south of border pillars 27/13 and 27/14 in front of Abziadi border post 2.

8. On 24 March 1995, a total of 31 Iraqi motor-boats and 2 liners carrying a total of 74 personnel were observed patrolling the Arvand Rud.

9. On 24 March 1995, Iraqi forces began constructing a new base near the geographical coordinates of TQ 160-230 on the map of Hosseinieh, in no man's land, north of border pillar 7/27 and south of border pillar 7/28.

10. On 27 March 1995, Iraqi forces were observed trafficking and installing a wireless antenna pole on the newly built base at the geographical coordinates of TQ 160-220 on the map of Hosseinieh, north of border pillar 7/26 and south of border pillar 7/27.

11. On 27 March 1995, at 2100 hours, a number of Iraqi forces began firing from Ali-Mir Village in no man's land at the geographical coordinates of ND 589-248 on the map of Qasr-e-Shirin towards the Iranian border police who were stationed at the geographical coordinates of ND 590-230 on the map of Qasr-e-Shirin.

12. On 28 March 1995, at 1010 hours, an Iraqi reconnaissance aircraft was observed flying near the geographical coordinates of NC 832-193 on the map of Halaleh, in no man's land, Meimak Heights, Shohada Hill.

13. On 28 March 1995, at 1300 hours, Iraqi forces again set up a dish antenna (which had already been removed by Iraqi forces) near the geographical coordinates of 432-657 on the map of Naftshahr, in no man's land, east of Iraq's Chalaie post, west of the Kaneh-Kaboud border river.

14. On 28 March 1995, 32 Iraqi motor-boats and a liner with a total of 74 personnel were observed patrolling the Arvand Rud.

15. On 29 March 1995, an Iraqi helicopter was observed flying over the area of Khosravi, in Iraqi territory.

16. On 29 March 1995, Iraqi forces deployed a four-barrel anti-aircraft cannon near the geographical coordinates of ND 425-975 on the map of Khosravi, east of Halawan and Bamil in Iraq and south-west of Chirzad and border pillars 51 and 52.

17. On 30 March 1995, Iraqi forces set up a wireless antenna near the geographical coordinates of TP 160-210 on the map of Hosseinieh, in no man's land, north of border pillar 7/25 and south of border pillar 7/26.

18. On 31 March 1995, at 1030 hours, five Iraqi forces were observed constructing five individual bunkers near the geographical coordinates of NC 405-095 on the map of Khosravi, west of Al-Meghdad post in Iraq and south of border pillar 55 and 55/1. They left the area at 1530 hours on the same day.

19. On 31 March 1995, at 1900 hours, 14 patrol vehicles (truck, Toyota, pick-up and patrol) were stationed in a military town located near the geographical coordinates of PB 350004200 on the map of Kouhe-Tunnel, south of border pillar 25/11.

It would be highly appreciated if the present letter could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
