FINANCING AND LIQUIDATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS TRANSITIONAL AUTHORITY IN CAMBODIA

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1994, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-ninth session the item entitled "Financing and liquidation of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the reports of the Secretary-General (A/49/714 and Corr.1 and 2 and Add.1) and of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/49/867).
- 3. The Committee considered the item at its 66th meeting, on 14 July 1995. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/49/SR.66).

II. CONSIDERATION OF A DRAFT DECISION ORALLY PROPOSED BY THE CHAIRMAN

4. At the 66th meeting on 14 July, the Chairman orally proposed, and the Committee adopted, a decision entitled "Financing and Liquidation of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia" (see para. 5).

III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Financing and Liquidation of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia

The General Assembly:

- (a) Decides to defer consideration of the item entitled "Financing and Liquidation of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia" to its fiftieth session;
- (b) Reiterates its request to the Secretary-General, contained in paragraph 11 of its resolution 48/255 of 26 May 1994, to provide to the General Assembly a comprehensive evaluation of all aspects of the administration and management of the operation, with a view to utilizing this experience in other peace-keeping operations, to be submitted to the Assembly at its fiftieth regular session.
