Corrigendum

1. Page 20, paragraph 61

At the end of the paragraph insert

"At the same time, in these cases such educational precepts and instructions as may facilitate the application of statutory legislation should be established, as custom has much force in those countries."

2. Page 145

Insert the following new paragraph 146 (a):

The Executive Director of UNITAR stated that the Institute was concerned both with the role of women in development and with the status of women in the United Nations. A UNITAR research team had found that women were integrated in economic development world-wide. However, because of a continually perceived dichotomy between modern and traditional sectors, statistics have undervalued women's contribution to the modern monetary economy. While active participants in economic development, women were excluded from economic and political decision-making, development planning and implementation. Just as unequal involvement of other dominated sectors meant giving them less power because of their inability to compete, so women suffered a loss of self-determination. The unequal use and distribution of resources and power that characterized the present world order all militated against women's greater involvement in national and international affairs. Change in attitudes should be achieved by linking the integration of women in national life with the relevant international questions of our time such as poverty, unemployment, liberation and peace. He noted the decision by the General Assembly at its thirty-fourth session to locate the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research within UNITAR until the second special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament, and stressed the importance that UNITAR placed on the role of women
