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REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING
THE SITUATION IN ABKHAZIA, GEORGIA

Addendum

1. In my report to the Security Council of 18 March 1994 (S/1994/312), I recommended in paragraph 12 that UNOMIG be extended for a further three months, to 30 June 1993. It is also my recommendation that UNOMIG be maintained at its current strength, which stands at 22 military observers including the Chief Military Observers.
2. Should the Security Council approve my recommendations, it is estimated that the total cost would amount to approximately \$1,005,000 gross for the three-month period. The monthly cost thereafter would amount to approximately \$335,000 gross. A breakdown of the estimated cost by main categories of expenditure is provided for information purposes in the annex to the present addendum.
3. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly, should the Security Council decide to approve my recommendations, that the costs relating thereto should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessments to be levied on Member States should be credited to the UNOMIG special account established for this purpose.
