CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS SUBMITTED BY STATES PARTIES  
UNDER ARTICLE 19 OF THE CONVENTION

Second periodic reports of States parties due in 1993

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, the States parties shall submit to the Committee against Torture, through the Secretary-General of the United Nations, reports on the measures they have taken to give effect to their undertakings under the Convention, within one year after the entry into force of the Convention for the State party concerned. Thereafter the States parties shall submit supplementary reports every four years on any new measures taken and such other reports as the Committee may request.

2. Accordingly, the first supplementary (second periodic) reports under article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention are due in 1993 from nine States parties on the following dates:

China	2 November 1993
Colombia	6 January 1993
Ecuador	28 April 1993
Greece	4 November 1993
Guyana	17 June 1993
Peru	5 August 1993
Tunisia	22 October 1993
Turkey	31 August 1993
