Letter dated 11 August 1995 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of
the Permanent Mission of Yugoslavia to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

I am writing to you concerning the letters from the Permanent Representatives of Croatia (A/50/333-S/1995/659) and Slovenia (A/50/334-S/1995/661) addressed to you.

Those letters represent a continuation of the propaganda campaign of the above-mentioned former Yugoslav republics and contain a malicious interpretation of the position of the United Nations concerning the status of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in the United Nations.

They testify to their authors' lack of knowledge of international law and the practice of international relations, particularly regarding the United Nations and to the fact that their sole goal was to satisfy certain internal political needs.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 8 of the provisional agenda, and of the Security Council.
