LETTER DATED 16 AUGUST 1995 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 724 (1991) CONCERNING YUGOSLAVIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On behalf of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 724 (1991) concerning Yugoslavia, I have the honour to apprise you that, according to a report dated 10 August 1995 by the Executive Director of the Danube Commission, completion of the repairs to the locks of the Iron Gates I system on the right-hand bank of the Danube would require an additional 60 days.

The Committee considered the report and decided to notify the Security Council hereby, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Council resolution 992 (1995), that a further period of 60 days is required for completion of the necessary repairs to the locks of the Iron Gates I system on the right-hand bank of the Danube.

It is the Committee's understanding that, unless the Security Council decides otherwise, resolution 992 (1995), which came into force on 23 June 1995 for a period of 60 days, shall remain in force for another period of 60 days, starting from 22 August and ending on 20 October 1995, subject to paragraph 6 of that resolution.
