Letter dated 21 August 1995 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina addressed to the President of the Security Council

Today three children were senselessly murdered by Serbian shelling of Goražde. When will enough be enough and what will it take for the United Nations and the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) to react to this terrorism?

The failure to respond can only be characterized as a further betrayal of your commitments and of the "peace initiative" now being launched.

The Secretary-General had assured us that the withdrawal of the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) from Goražde would not deter the previously given commitment.

The ever-increasing string of broken promises can only be characterized as shameful.
