NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At its 92nd plenary meeting on 11 December 1980, the General Assembly adopted resolution 35/122,* entitled "Report of the Special Committee to Investigate Israeli Practices Affecting the Human Rights of the Population of the Occupied Territories". In paragraph 5 of resolution 35/122 F, the General Assembly

"Requests the Security Council to convene urgently in order to take the necessary measures, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the United Nations, to ensure that the Government of Israel, the occupying Power, rescinds the illegal measures taken against the Palestinian Mayors and the Sharia Judge Tamimi, and to facilitate their immediate return so that they can resume the functions for which they were elected."
