- Mr. Zhong Shukong. Ms. Daes subsequently joined the sponsors.
- 2. Ms. Warzazi revised the text of the draft resolution by adding a new operative paragraph 4 reading as follows:

"Expresses the hope that the Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination Against Women will be integrated as soon as possible with the other human rights treaty monitoring mechanisms."

- 3. The draft resolution, as revised, was adopted without a vote.
