Addendum

1. The purpose of the present addendum is to update the annex to the report of the Secretary-General of 15 November 1993 (A/C.5/48/26), which was submitted in accordance with General Assembly decision 47/474 of 14 September 1993 and which contains information concerning the designation of special representatives and envoys. The revised annex reflects the number of special representatives and envoys as of 29 April 1994 financed under the 1994-1995 programme budget or from other sources of financing.

2. In summary, as of 29 April 1994, there were 23 officials assigned to peace-keeping missions (7 at the under-secretary-general level, 16 at the assistant secretary-general level) and 13 officials performing good offices or related functions (10 at the under-secretary-general level and 3 at the assistant secretary-general level), 3 of whom are assisting the Secretary-General on the basis of \$1-a-year honorarium or reimbursement of travel expenses; and, finally, 4 officials assisting the Secretary-General in various capacities, 1 of whom is on a \$1-a-year honorarium.
