SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

At its 3369th meeting, held on 27 April 1994, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, the Security Council continued its consideration of the item, which had been started at the 3356th meeting, on 31 March 1994.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/1994/487), which had been submitted by France, the Russian Federation, Spain and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Security Council then proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1994/487 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 914 (1994) (for the full text, see S/RES/914 (1994); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Forty-ninth Year, Resolutions and decisions of the Security Council, 1994).

By a letter dated 22 April 1994 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1994/492), the Permanent Representative of Pakistan to the United Nations and Chairman of the Organization of Islamic Conference (OIC) Contact Group requested, in his capacity as the Chairman of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers, to have a formal meeting of the Security Council scheduled in the afternoon of Wednesday, 27 April 1994, on the situation in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina in order to facilitate a debate by the Members of the United Nations on the constantly deteriorating conditions there. The specific date was being suggested as eight Foreign Ministers of the States members of the Contact Group of OIC were visiting New York to hold an emergency meeting of OIC and wished to avail themselves of that opportunity to participate in the Security Council debate on 27 April 1994.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3370th meeting, held on 27 April 1994, in accordance with the above request.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Canada, Croatia, Egypt, Greece, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Malaysia, Norway, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, the Sudan, Sweden, Tunisia and Turkey, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In response to the request contained in a letter dated 27 April 1994 from the Permanent Representative of Pakistan to the United Nations (S/1994/507), the President, with the consent of the Council, also extended an invitation under

rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Hamid Algabid, the Secretary-General of the Organization of the Islamic Conference.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited Ambassador Dragomir Djokic, at his request, to address the Council in the course of the discussion of the item before it.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3371st meeting, held on 30 April 1994, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.
