"К настоящему прилагается уведомление о новом пересмотренном варианте норвежской схемы ВСП, действующем с 1 июля 1995 года. Эта схема заменяет временный план ВСП, принятый 1 января в связи с содержащимся в Соглашении по ВТО требованием о проведении тарификации всех нетарифных таможенных мер. Постоянное представительство просит обеспечить должное распространение прилагаемого уведомления".

НОРВЕЖСКАЯ СХЕМА ВСЕОБЩИХ ПРЕФЕРЕНЦИЙ (ВСП). ИМПОРТ СЕЛЬСКОХОЗЯЙСТВЕННЫХ ТОВАРОВ.

В связи с осуществлением Соглашения по ВТО с 1 января требовалось провести тарификацию всех нетарифных таможенных мер в части сельскохозяйственной продукции, а также пересмотр норвежской схемы ВСП. С 1 января вступил в силу временный план ВСП, а с 1 июля действует пересмотренная, новая схема. Новой схемой предусматривается значительное расширение охвата сельскохозяйственной продукции.

В отношении наименее развитых стран применяются следующие условия:

- беспошлинный и бесквотный доступ на рынок для всех сельскохозяйственных товаров, за исключением муки, зерна и кормовой продукции, по которым предусмотрено 30-процентное сокращение тарифов в пределах ориентировочных тарифных потолков (см. список 1). Тарифные сокращения исчисляются на базе применяемых тарифных ставок. При импорте муки, зерна, кормовой продукции и мяса из этих стран применяется процедура автоматического лицензирования.

В отношении других развивающихся стран схемой предусмотрено следующее:

- беспошлинный доступ на рынок для сельскохозяйственных товаров, перечисленных в списке 2;
- 100-процентное сокращение тарифов на промышленные компоненты сельскохозяйственных товаров, прошедших промышленную обработку (см. список 3);
- 50-процентное сокращение тарифов на растительные и животные жиры (см. список 4);
- 15-процентное сокращение тарифов на отдельные виды цветов, фруктов и овощей (см. список 5). В отношении товаров, включенных в этот список, действует процедура автоматического лицензирования.
- 10-процентное сокращение тарифов на муку, зерно и кормовую продукцию (см. список 1);
- 10-процентное сокращение тарифов на мясо и мясные продукты (см. список 6). В отношении товаров, включенных в этот список, действует процедура автоматического лицензирования.
- 10-процентное сокращение тарифов по товарам, на которые распространяются новые минимальные квоты ВТО для обеспечения доступа на рынок (см. список 7).

Все тарифные сокращения исчисляются на базе действующих тарифных ставок.

FLOUR. GRAINS AND FEEDING STUFFS WHICH ARE GIVEN A TARIFF REDUCTION OF 30% WHEN COMING FROM THE LEAST DEVELOPED COUNTRIES (LLDCs) AND A TARIFF REDUCTION OF 10% WHEN COMING FROM OTHER DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.

For least developing countries the 30% preference is given within an indicative tariff ceiling of 20,000 tons for protein feeding stuffs, 75,000 tons for curbohydrate feedings stuffs, and 100,000 tons for grain for human consumption.


