ORGANIZATION OF WORK OF THE THIRD COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretariat

Allocation of items

1. The agenda items allocated by the General Assembly to the Third Committee are listed in the letter dated 22 September 1995 from the President of the Assembly to the Chairman of the Third Committee (A/C.3/50/1). Background information on those items may be found in the annotations to the agenda (A/50/100). A list of documents submitted under the various agenda items allocated to the Third Committee is set out in an addendum to the present document (A/C.3/50/L.1/Add.1/Rev.1*).

Programme of work

2. The suggested programme of work annexed to the present document has been prepared bearing in mind paragraph (b) of rule 99 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, General Assembly resolution 45/175 of 18 December 1990 on the rationalization of the work of the Third Committee and General Assembly decision 49/459 of 23 December 1994 on the organization of work of the Third Committee and biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1995-1996. Other relevant resolutions and decisions adopted by the Assembly, the organizational arrangements agreed upon by the Assembly at the outset of its current session (A/50/250) and the availability of documentation, as well as past experience in the utilization of conference services have also been taken into account.

Length of statements

3. In view of the limited number of meetings available to the Committee during the session, it is suggested that the time-limit for statements be set at 10 minutes, with the exception of statements being made by the spokesmen of groups of delegations, which would be set at 15 minutes.

Conference facilities and meeting arrangements

4. Taking into account the availability of conference services for the Main Committees of the General Assembly, an average of seven formal meetings a week have been scheduled for the Third Committee. Unless otherwise specified, meetings will be held at 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. In this connection, the General Assembly has reminded delegations that punctuality is of the utmost importance in the interest of ensuring an effective and orderly completion of work and achieving necessary economies for the United Nations. There will be no possibility of meeting beyond 6 p.m. or of night meetings. As decided by the General Assembly, the requirement of the presence of at least one quarter of the members of the Third Committee to declare a meeting open and permit the debate to proceed has been waived.

Working Group of the Third Committee

5. It is proposed that the work of the Working Group should continue during the fiftieth session under agenda item 112 (d). In order to permit full participation of all representatives, meetings of the Working Group will, to the maximum extent possible, not take place at the same time as meetings of the Third Committee itself.

Observance of the Fiftieth Anniversary of the United Nations and the tenth anniversary of International Youth Year

- 6. The Committee is reminded that the Special Commemorative meetings for the Fiftieth Anniversary of the United Nations will take place on 23 and 24 October. No meetings of the Third Committee will be held on those days.
- 7. In addition, the General Assembly has decided that, in the light of resolution 49/152 of 23 December 1994, plenary meetings to mark the tenth anniversary of International Youth Year will be held on Thursday and Friday, 26 and 27 October 1995. Therefore, the Third Committee will not meet on those days.

Conclusion of the work of the Third Committee

8. Bearing in mind the allocation of the number of meetings available to the Third Committee and, in accordance with the recommendation of the General Assembly at its current session, it is proposed that the Committee set a target date of 1 December for the conclusion of its work.
