- 3. The Board noted that the International Savings Banks Institute (ISBI), which had been granted status in the special category by the Board at its thirteenth session, had been dissovled and that its activities had been taken over by the World Savings Banks Institute (WSBI). In accordance with the wishes of WSBI and the recommendation of the Secretary-General of UNCTAD, the Board agreed that WSBI be reclassified in the general category.
- 4. Accordingly, the number of non-governmental organizations included in the list provided for in rule 77 of the rules of procedure now totals 165: 79 in the $\underline{\text{General category}}$ and 86 in the $\underline{\text{Special category}}$.
