STATEMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CHILE

(Original: Spanish)

The Government of Chile expresses its rejection of the decision by France, announced yesterday by President Jacques Chirac, to resume nuclear tests for a limited period in the Muroroa atoll (South Pacific). This action is a serious threat to the conduct of the negotiations on the comprehensive nuclear test ban treaty, an aspiration which is of the highest priority for our country, and a serious challenge to disarmament initiatives in general.

The Government of Chile, reiterating a constant principle of its foreign policy, appeals urgently to the Government of France to reconsider this decision in the interests of the protection of human life and the environment, as well as respect for the commitment of the international community in the areas of disarmament and world security.
