ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE FIFTIETH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Second report of the General Committee

1. At its 3rd meeting, on 20 October 1995, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the Philippines (A/50/232) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

"Implementation of the outcome of the Fourth World Conference on Women: Action for Equality, Development and Peace".

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

(a) Should be included in the agenda;

(b) Should be considered directly in plenary meeting for the purpose of endorsing the Beijing Declaration and the Platform for Action; the item should also be allocated to the Second and Third Committees as appropriate for its substantive consideration.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Argentina, the Bahamas, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela (A/50/233) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional sub-item under item 112 (Human rights questions) entitled:

"Report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights".
