NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 JUNE 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO
THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, pursuant to paragraph 13 of Security Council resolution 917 (1994), has the honour to inform him that the sanctions against Haiti have been implemented by the following statutory instruments: the Haiti (United Nations Sanctions) Order 1994 (S.I.1994/1323), the Haiti (United Nations Sanctions) (Dependent Territories) Order 1994 (S.I.1994/1324), the Haiti (United Nations Sanctions) Isle of Man Order 1994 (S.I.1994/1325) and the Haiti (United Nations Sanctions) (Channel Islands) Order 1994 (S.I.1994/1326). The Orders in Council were made on 18 May 1994 and came into force on 23 May 1994. Copies of this legislation are attached.*
