CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE FORTY-EIGHTH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Third report of the Credentials Committee

Chairman: Mr. Nitya PIBULSONGGRAM (Thailand)

- 1. The Credentials Committee held its 3rd meeting on 17 June 1994.
- 2. The Committee had before it a memorandum by the Secretary-General, dated 16 June 1994, concerning the credentials of representatives of Member States participating in the forty-eighth session of the General Assembly, other than the credentials of the representatives accepted by the Credentials Committee at its 1st and 2nd meetings, held respectively on 14 October 1993 (A/48/512) and 15 December 1993 (A/48/512/Add.1).
- 3. A statement relating to the memorandum by the Secretary-General was made by the representative of the Secretary-General, the Legal Counsel.
- 4. As noted in paragraph 6 of the memorandum, since the 2nd meeting of the Credentials Committee, formal credentials in the form required by rule 27 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly had been received from the following seven Member States: Colombia, Lebanon, Mali, Monaco, Nicaragua, Solomon Islands and South Africa.
- 5. The Chairman proposed that the Committee accept the credentials of representatives of the Member States referred to in paragraph 6 of the Secretary-General's memorandum and, in this regard, suggested the following draft resolution for adoption by the Committee:

"The Credentials Committee

"<u>Having examined</u> the credentials of the representatives to the forty-eighth session of the General Assembly of the Member States referred to in the memorandum of the Secretary-General dated 16 June 1994,

 $\ensuremath{"{\rm \underline{Accepts}}}$ the credentials of the representatives of the Member States concerned."

- 6. The draft resolution was adopted by the Committee without a vote.
- 7. The Chairman proposed that the Committee should recommend to the General Assembly the approval of the report of the Committee (see para. 9). The proposal of the Chairman was adopted without a vote.
- 8. In the light of the foregoing, the present report is submitted to the General Assembly.
