LETTER DATED 30 JUNE 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MEXICO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I am pleased to transmit the following information concerning Mexico's compliance with the measures contained in Security Council resolution 883 (1993).

On 27 June 1994, the Official Gazette of the Federation published a Decision of the Secretariat of Trade and Industrial Development prohibiting the exportation to the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya of the items listed in the annex to Security Council resolution 883 (1993), as well as the provision of equipment, supplies and grants of licensing arrangements for the manufacture or maintenance of such items.

While this Decision entered into force on 28 June 1994, thus guaranteeing full compliance with resolution 883 (1993), the Government of Mexico had already taken the relevant measures in due form at an earlier date.

I should be grateful if you would have this information circulated as a document of the Security Council.
