PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1994-1995

LAW OF THE SEA

## Draft decision submitted by the Chairman

The Fifth Committee, having considered the report of the Secretary-General  $\underline{1}/$  and the corresponding report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,  $\underline{2}/$  decides:

- (a) That, should the General Assembly adopt draft resolution A/48/L.60, and in particular paragraph 8 thereof, the maximum requirements for the United Nations regular budget for the period 1994-1999 could be \$25,438,500 and the maximum additional appropriation which may be required for the biennium 1994-1995 would be \$439,800;
- (b) To revert to the matter at the forty-ninth session of the General Assembly in the light of a review of the work programme that gives rise to the above estimates by the relevant intergovernmental body and a further report by the Advisory Committee, including in particular on the issue of the budgetary procedure addressed by the Advisory Committee in paragraph 4 of its report.  $\underline{2}$ /
