DRAFT REPORT OF THE 1993 UNITED NATIONS PLEDGING CONFERENCE FOR DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

1. By its resolution 45/215 of 21 December 1990, entitled "United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities", the General Assembly decided, inter alia, that the adoption and signing of the Final Act of the Conference should be replaced by the adoption of a procedural report of the Conference.

A. Opening and duration of the Conference

- 2. The Conference was held at United Nations Headquarters on 2 and 3 November 1993.
- 3. The Conference was opened by the Secretary-General.

C. <u>Election of officers</u>

- 6. The Conference elected, by acclamation, Mr. Byung Yong Soh (Republic of Korea) President of the Conference.
- 7. The Conference elected, also by acclamation, Mr. Peter R. Post (Netherlands) Vice-President of the Conference.

- 8. The Conference had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General on contributions pledged or paid at the 1992 United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities as at 30 June 1993 (A/CONF.160/2);
- (b) Background information on programmes and funds for the 1993 United Nations Pledging Conference for Development Activities.

E. Announcement of pledges

9. The Conference heard the announcement of pledges by a number of Governments to one or more programmes and funds and also noted that several Governments were not in a position to announce their contributions but proposed to communicate their announcement of such contributions to the Secretary-General as soon as they were in a position to do so after the closure of the Conference.
