REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

1. At its third plenary meeting on 14 November 1995, the Conference, in accordance with rule 5 of the rules of procedure, appointed nine members of the Credentials Committee: China, Nepal, Nigeria, Russian Federation, Spain, South Africa, Trinidad and Tobago, United States of America and Venezuela.
2. The Committee held a meeting on 20 November 1995 and elected Ambassador Trevor Spencer (Trinidad and Tobago) as Chairman.
3. Credentials, in conformity with rule 4 of the rules of procedure, had been received for the representatives participating in the Conference.
4. The Committee found the credentials of the representatives participating in the Conference to be in due and proper form, and recommends that they be accepted.
