LETTER DATED 13 NOVEMBER 1995 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to resolution 866 (1993) of 22 September 1993, by which the Security Council authorized the establishment of the United Nations Observer Mission in Liberia (UNOMIL), and to resolution 1020 (1995) of 10 November 1995, by which the Council decided to adjust the mandate of UNOMIL.

Following the usual consultations, it is my intention to appoint Major-General Mahmoud Talha of Egypt as Chief Military Observer of UNOMIL. General Talha will replace Major-General Daniel I. Opande of Kenya, who returned to his national service on 30 May 1995.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Council.
