SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS
OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE
STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1994/20 of 20 January 1994, S/1994/20/Add.3 of 3 February 1994, S/1994/20/Add.12 of 8 April 1994, S/1994/20/Add.14 of 21 April 1994 and S/1994/20/Add.21 of 10 June 1994.

During the week ending 9 July 1994, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3401st meeting, held on 8 July 1994, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1994/805), which had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council adopted without a vote draft resolution S/1994/805 as resolution 936 (1994) (for the full text, see S/RES/936 (1994); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Forty-ninth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1994).
