LETTER DATED 25 JULY 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and with reference to the letter dated 17 June 1994 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to you (S/1994/726), we should like to state that the references it contains to alleged violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire and the provisions governing the area of separation between the two countries are pure inventions that the Iranian regime has persisted in fabricating with a view to creating an unwarranted climate of tension.

In calling attention to this trend towards escalation on the part of the Iranian regime, my Government affirms its compliance with the cease-fire and with the provisions governing the area of separation.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
