## Page 10, paragraph 21

For the existing text substitute

21. Preliminary data (WHO/UNICEF, Joint Monitoring Programme (JMP), 1995) on the trend in water and sanitation service expansion between 1990 and 1994 suggest that the average rate of improvement in coverage in all geographic regions will not lead to the achievement of the goals. It is clear that "business as usual" - continuation of the same policies, strategies, funding levels and implementation rates - will not keep pace with the population that needs to be served by the year 2000 (see figure II above). Clearly a higher level of effort is required to face the challenge of universal coverage.
