INTRODUCTORY NOTE

This *List* should be used in conjunction with *United Nations Documentation: a brief guide* (ST/LIB/34/Rev.2).

Entries are in English only while multilingual texts are also noted.

This publication comprises a list of reference sources on United Nations documentation which may be used by anyone who is setting up a core reference collection in a depository library or other United Nations documentation centre. It should be useful for training workshops and seminars on the use of United Nations documents.

Materials listed include information on the history of the Organization as well as its structure and substantive activities or programmes. It also includes catalogues, indexes, dictionaries, glossaries and sources of economic, social, statistical, legal and political information.

The materials listed are published mainly by the United Nations. Externally published works are included for their uniqueness. **Reference sources published after 31 August 1995 are not included.**

Titles which continue to be core reference sources (e.g. *United Nations Documents Index (UNDI)*, 1950-1973) are included even if they are out-of-print.

Annotations are provided for selected entries and open entries are given for some recurrent publications.

Entries are divided into seven parts. Within each part, publications are listed in alphabetical order with the exception of entries in Chapter I on *Basic Texts*.

والمواد المدرجة في هذه القائمة هي أساسا من منشورات الأمم المتحدة. أما الأعمال المنشورة خارجيا التي تتضمنها القائمة فهي التي تكون ذات طابع فريد من نوعه. ولا تتضمن القائمة المصادر المرجعية التي نشرت بعد ٣١ آب/أغسطس ١٩٩٥.

وتتضمن القائمة المراجع التي لا تزال تشكل مصادر مرجعية رئيسية حتى وإن كانت طبعتها قد نفذت (مثل فهرس وثائق الأمم المتحدة، ١٩٥٠ - ١٩٧٣:

本出版物所载联合国文件参考书清单，可供任何人用来在托存图书馆或其他联合国文件中心设立一个核心参考书收藏。也应对教人使用联合国文件的培训讲习班和讨论会有帮助。

所列材料包括关于联合国历史以及联合国结构和实质性活动或方案的资料。还包括目录、索引、字典、词汇以及经济、社会、统计、法律和政治资料的来源。

清单所列主要是联合国出版的材料。只有非常独特的外界出版物才列入其中。1995年8月31日以后出版的参考书没有列入。

核心参考书(例如《联合国文件索引》(UNDI), 1950-19'3), 即使已经绝版, 仍然列入。

某些条目有附加说明, 某些周期性刊物有首刊说明。

本《清单》分为七部分。除了题为“基本文件”的第1章之外, 每一部分内的出版物都按字母顺序排列。

Les références bibliographiques sont en anglais uniquement, mais les textes multilingues sont signalés en tant que tels.

Cette publication présente une liste de documents de référence sur la documentation des Nations Unies. Cette bibliographie peut servir à toute personne chargée de constituer une collection de référence de base au sein d'une bibliothèque dépositaire ou de tout autre centre de documentation des Nations Unies. Elle peut également être utile lors de l'organisation d'ateliers ou séminaires de formation sur l'utilisation de la documentation des Nations Unies.

Les références se rapportent à l'histoire de l'Organisation ainsi qu'à sa structure et ses activités ou programmes de fonds. Sont également inclus dans la liste : catalogues, bulletins et index, dictionnaires, glossaires et documents relatifs à l'information économique, sociale, statistique, juridique et politique.

La plupart des documents cités sont publiés par les Nations Unies. Les publications externes aux Nations Unies sont signalées ici en fonction de leur caractère unique. Aucun document publié après le 31 août 1995 ne figure dans cette bibliographie.

Quelques titres, bien qu'épuisés, restent des ouvrages de référence essentiels, comme par exemple *United Nations Documents Index* (UNDI), 1950-1973. C'est à ce titre qu'ils se trouvent inclus dans la présente liste.

Un certain nombre de références sont complétées par des notes et certaines publications en série font l'objet d'entrées en cours.

Les références qui composent la bibliographie sont réparties en sept parties, à l'intérieur desquelles les titres sont classés par ordre alphabétique, à l'exception des références figurant dans le chapitre premier *Basic Texts* [Documents de base].

Он будет полезен для проведения семинаров и практикумов по вопросам работы с документами Организации Объединенных Наций.

Перечисленные в нем материалы включают информацию об истории организации, а также о ее структуре, основной деятельности и программах. Перечень также включает каталоги, указатели, словари, глоссарии и информационные материалы по экономической, социальной, статистической, правовой и политической тематике.

Перечисленные материалы в основном являются изданиями Организации Объединенных Наций. Работы, опубликованные за пределами организации, включены в силу уникальности содержащейся в них информации. **Справочные материалы, опубликованные после 31 августа 1995 года, в перечень не включены.**

Информация об изданиях, сохраняющих свое ключевое информационное значение (например, "Указатель документов Организации Объединенных Наций" (ЮНДИ), 1950-1973), включена в перечень даже в тех случаях, когда они уже распроданы.

К отдельным материалам даются аннотации, а в отношении некоторых периодических изданий указываются даты начала публикации.

Библиографические описания в перечне объединены в семь разделов. В каждом разделе публикации расположены в алфавитном порядке, за исключением описаний, содержащихся в первом разделе, озаглавленном "Basic Texts"

La presente *Lista* debe usarse junto con *La Documentación de las Naciones Unidas: una guía breve* (ST/LIB/34/Rev.2).

Las referencias bibliográficas se proporcionan en inglés solamente mientras que los textos multilingües se indican tal como aparecen originalmente.

Esta publicación presenta una lista de obras de referencia sobre la documentación de las Naciones Unidas y puede ser utilizada por cualquiera persona que esté encargada del establecimiento de una colección básica de referencia en una biblioteca depositaria o algún centro de documentación de Naciones Unidas. Puede ser igualmente de utilidad para la organización de talleres o seminarios de adiestramiento sobre el uso de documentos de Naciones Unidas.

La lista de referencias se refiere a la historia de la Organización tanto como de su estructura y actividades o programas sustantivos. La Lista incluye también catálogos, índices, diccionarios, glosarios y obras de información económica, social, estadística, legal y política.

La mayor parte de los documentos citados son publicados por las Naciones Unidas. La publicaciones externas a las Naciones Unidas se señalan en función de su carácter único. No se incluye ningún documento publicado después del 31 de agosto de 1995.

Los títulos que permanecen como fuente básica de referencia (por ejemplo, *United Nations Documents Index* (UNDI), 1950-1973) están incluidos aunque estén fuera de prensa.

Se incluyen notas para un cierto número de referencias seleccionadas y se establecen referencias abiertas para algunas publicaciones en serie.

Las referencias que componen esta Lista se dividen en siete partes. Dentro de cada parte, las publicaciones están ordenadas en forma alfabética, con la excepción de las referencias incluidas en el Capítulo I sobre *Basic Texts* [Documentos de Base].

Covers 1945-1965. Paperbound and clothbound.

9th edition. Change of title: *Everyone's United Nations.* 1979, 477 p. Sales No. 79.I.5.

Covers 1966-1978 and forms a companion volume to the 8th edition.

10th edition. 1986, 484 p. Sales No. 85.I.16. Paperbound and clothbound.

Covers first 40 years of the Organization's activities and focuses on the period 1978 to 1985.

Explains the structure, tells the story of the work of the United Nations and describes the specialized agencies.

Chronicles details regarding the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons. Contains an introduction by the Secretary-General of the United Nations and texts of key documents.

Includes a table showing member States of each organization of the United Nations system, a list of UNDP and "operational activities for development" resident representatives, directors of United Nations information centres, and an alphabetical index of organs of the United Nations system.

18. *Who's Who in the United Nations and Related Agencies*. 2nd edition. Edited by S.R. Greenfield. Prepared in cooperation with the United Nations. Detroit: Omnigraphics, Inc., 1992, 850 p.

Gives brief biographies of some 3,000 senior officials of the secretariats of organizations in the United Nations system and members of diplomatic missions to the United Nations who served during 1991.

19. *Worldmark Encyclopedia of the Nations*. 7th edition. New York: Worldmark Press, 1988. Issued in 5 volumes: vol. 1: United Nations; vol. 2: Africa; vol. 3: Americas; vol. 4: Asia and Oceania; vol. 5: Europe.

Volume 1 covers the origin, structure, financing, functions and major activities of the United Nations and the specialized agencies.

22. *Catalogue of United Nations Publications.*

Annual, with an update in the middle of the year. Lists United Nations sales publications currently available. Latest covers 1994/95.

23. *Publications of the International Court of Justice: Catalogue.*

Lists publications of the ICJ from its establishment in 1946 until 1 July 1994. ICJ publications are issued in the following series: *Reports of Judgments, Advisory Opinions and Orders; Pleadings, Oral Arguments, Documents; Acts and Documents concerning the Organization of the Court; Yearbook; and Bibliography*. The *Catalogue* is arranged numerically, by ICJ sales number. Includes chronological index of *Reports of Judgments, Advisory Opinions and Orders*, and alphabetical index of cases. - (i) *ST/SGB/- series*. These bulletins establish Financial Rules, Staff Rules, the organizational structure of the Secretariat and other important decisions of policy.
 - (ii) *ST/AI/- series*. Prescribe procedures for the implementation of the Secretary-General's bulletins and also set forth office practices and procedures to be applied in one or more departments of the Secretariat.
 - (iii) *ST/IC/- series*. These circulars deal with matters of general but one-time interest, matters of general interest for a specific period, informational material or requests for staff cooperation.

Can be used to trace the history of an item such as the Middle East situation, United Nations personnel questions, or the budget.
