SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/13737 of 11 January 1980, S/13737/Add.35 of 10 September 1980 and S/13737/Add.38 of 3 October 1980.

During the week ending 15 November 1980, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed therein.

At its 2255th meeting, held on 12 November 1980, the Security Council considered the item entitled "The date of elections to fill two vacancies in the International Court of Justice" and unanimously adopted resolution 480 (1980), which reads as follows:

The Security Council,

Noting with regret the deaths of Judge Richard R. Baxter on 25 September 1980 and of Judge Salah El Dine Tarazi on 4 October 1980,

Noting further that two vacancies in the International Court of Justice for the remainder of the terms of office of the deceased judges have thus occurred and must be filled in accordance with the terms of the Statute of the Court,

Noting that, in accordance with Article 14 of the Statute, the date of the elections to fill these vacancies shall be fixed by the Security Council,

Decides that elections to fill the vacancies shall take place on 15 January 1981 at a meeting of the Security Council and at a meeting of the resumed thirty-fifth session of the General Assembly.
