Note 2: A working group on item 3(i) (Portable tanks) is scheduled from 28 November to 2 December 1994; a working group on the rationalization of the Manual of Tests and Criteria (item 3(b)(ii)) is scheduled from 28 and 29 November 1994.

- Note 3:** Submissions should be concise and as short as possible, they should include a justification. The number of proposals in a single document should be limited; they should all relate to the same subject under one agenda item or sub-item.
- Note 4:** The deadline for submission of proposals is **16 September 1994**. Amendment proposals should relate to the work of the Sub-Committee. The Sub-Committee considered at its eighth session that, in principle, no new proposals should be submitted directly to the Committee without the subject having first been discussed by the Sub-Committee. Therefore new issues raised after the ninth session of the Sub-Committee should be deferred to the next biennium.
- Note 5:** An annotated agenda will be circulated at a later stage on the basis of submissions received by 16 September 1994. For reasons of economy, delegates are kindly asked to bring their own copies of background documents to the meeting and not to request additional copies.
