Corrigendum

Page 14, paragraph 67

For the existing text substitute

67. The representative of the host country pointed out that her Government had not been invited to participate in the Task Force created by the Secretary-General on the INSTRAW-UNIFEM merger and that no formal negotiations between the United Nations and the host Government had so far taken place. She pointed out that the failure of the United Nations to consult with her Government was a discourtesy to her country. The representative also pointed out that it had been suggested that the current INSTRAW facilities be used as a general training centre without the host country being consulted beforehand. She then drew the attention of the Board to the fact that the building had been donated to INSTRAW by the Dominican Republic and stated that if the United Nations decided for one reason or another to remove INSTRAW from the Dominican Republic, then the building would have to be returned to the country.
